The vacation starts on October 12 and ends on October 31. How many days of vacation are there?

$31 - 12$

In the beginning of the school year, Sarah bought colored pencils, 4 pens and 3 notebooks. She bought \$17 worth of school supplies. She had \$20 in her wallet. How much did the store assistant give back to her?
