



Word Problems: Decimals

Solve the problems using addition and subtraction

A chemist poured 3.96ml of water into a test tube then 2.92ml of a liquid chemical. How much liquid is there in his test tube?

Alex and Sophie got to the supermarket. They leave home with \$69.97 in their pockets. When they return, they only have \$4.25 left. How much did they spend in the supermarket?

Peter went on a trip. His suitcase weighed 24.4lbs on the way there. On the way back it weighed 18.12lbs. How many pounds lighter was his suitcase on the way back?

Christopher's rain gauge showed that it rained 7.4 inches yesterday. Today it rained 6.9 inches. How many inches does the rain gauge show today?

Christopher's rain gauge showed that it rained 4.4 inches yesterday. Today it rained 8.2 inches. How many inches does the rain gauge show today?

Natasha buys a bunch of roses for \$6.50 and a vase for \$13.25. At the cash register she gives a bill of \$20. How much change does the cashier give her?
