



Word Problems: Adding and Subtracting

Solve the problems using addition and subtraction

Jacob and his friends caught 36 fish. They put 5 back in the water. How many fish do they have left?

Jasmine collects stamps and has 84 stamps in her album. She takes out 5 because they are doubles. How many stamps does Jasmine have now?

Peter breeds sheep and counts them every day. In the morning, he had 49 sheep and in the evening, he had 5 sheep. How many sheep did Peter lose?
