

Word Problems: Adding and Subtracting

Solve the problems using addition and subtraction

Jack has invited friends over. He invited 15 people. 4 of them couldn't come, so he also invited 6 other people. How many friends are at Jack's house?

William wants to make a flower bouquet for his mom. He buys 9 white roses, 9 red roses, and 7 tulips. His bouquet is too big and so he takes out 3 flowers. How many flowers are left in the bouquet?

Claire is buying fruit at the market. She asks for 2 apples, 8 pears, and 3 oranges. When she is about to pay, Claire realizes that she has too much fruit. She puts back 3 oranges and 2 apples. How much fruit does she have left?
