



# Reducing Fractions

Reduce the fractions by finding the missing numbers.

$$\frac{16}{40} = \frac{4 \quad x}{4 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{27}{45} = \frac{3 \quad x}{3 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{24}{54} = \frac{3 \quad x}{3 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{48}{64} = \frac{4 \quad x}{4 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{36}{81} = \frac{3 \quad x}{3 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{9}{54} = \frac{3 \quad x}{3 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{27}{63} = \frac{3 \quad x}{3 \quad x}$$

$$\frac{12}{28} = \frac{2 \quad x}{2 \quad x}$$
